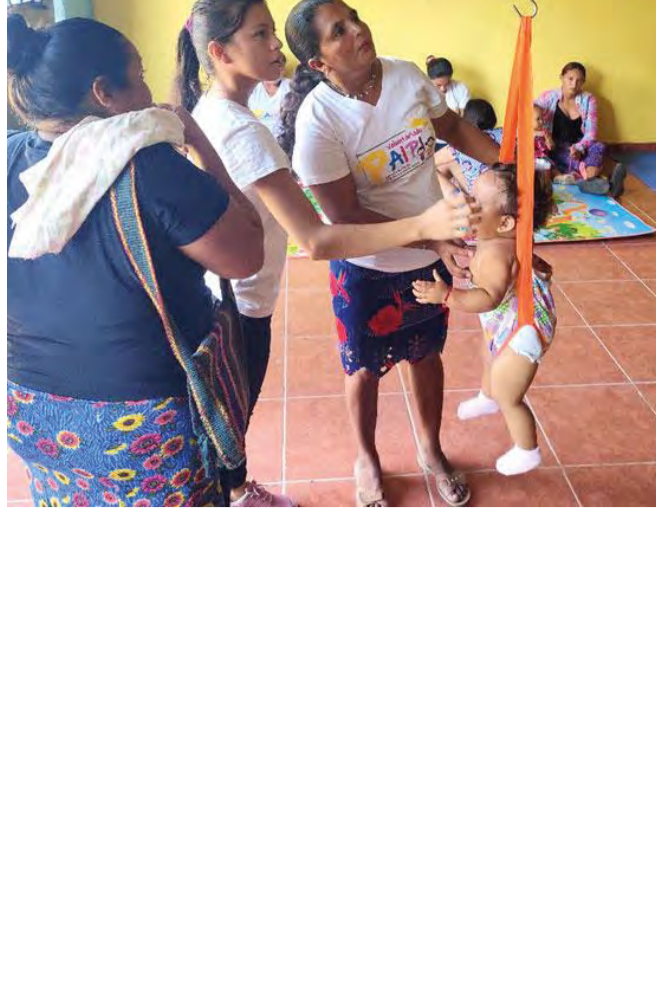
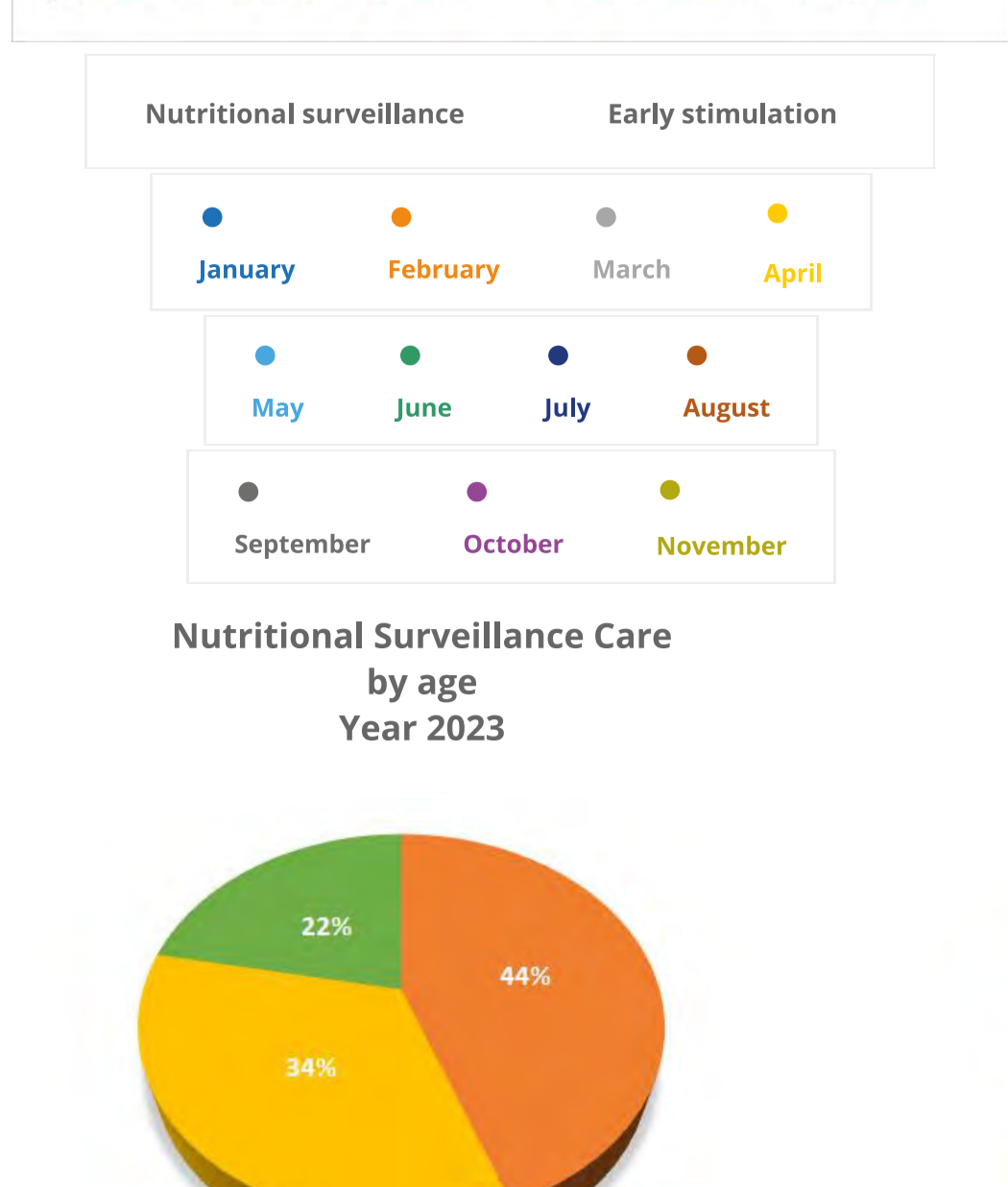


Comprehensive care for early childhood

During 2023, 232 nutritional surveillance sessions were held, providing a total of 5,203 services to 1,073 children aged 0 to 5 years from 18 communities.

123 children at risk of being underweight received home visits for follow-up.

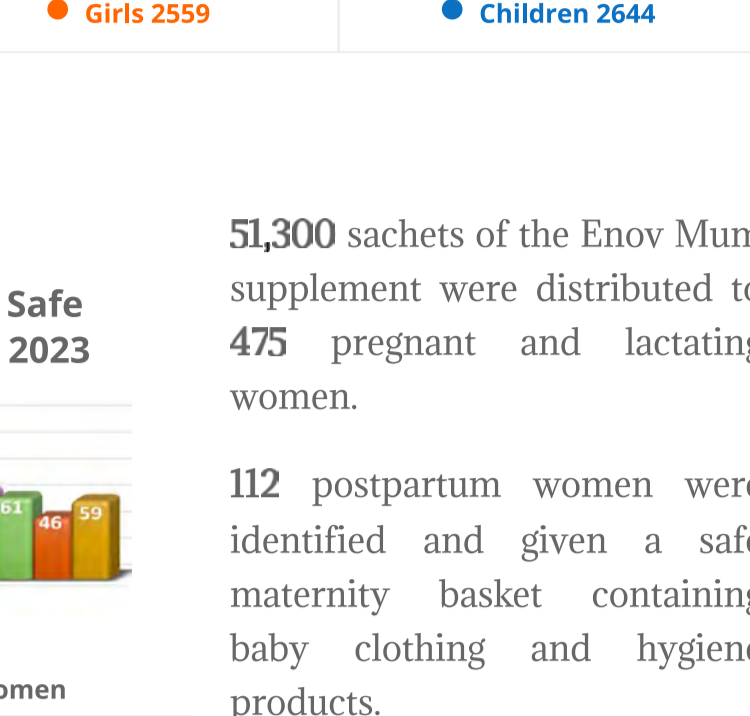

Nutritional Surveillance Care by age Year 2023



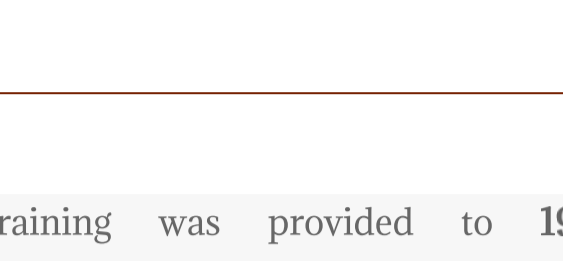
Nutritional Surveillance Care by sex Year 2023

Pregnant women in Safe Maternity Club Year 2023

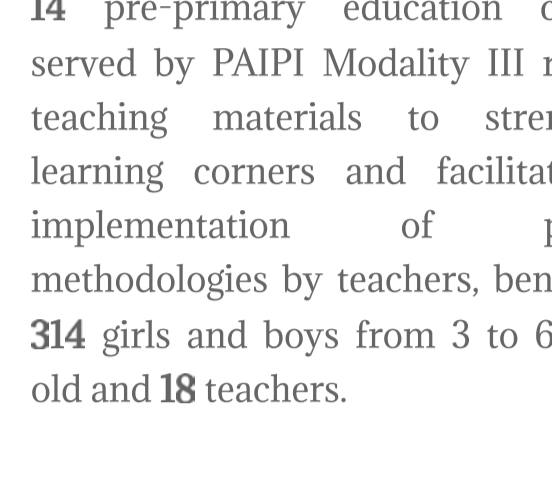


Assistance for pregnant women

112 postpartum women were identified and given a safe maternity basket containing baby clothing and hygiene products.

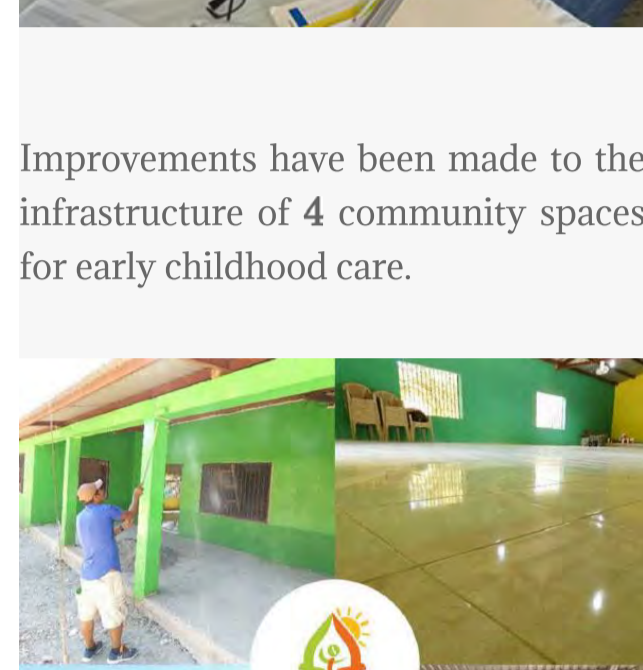

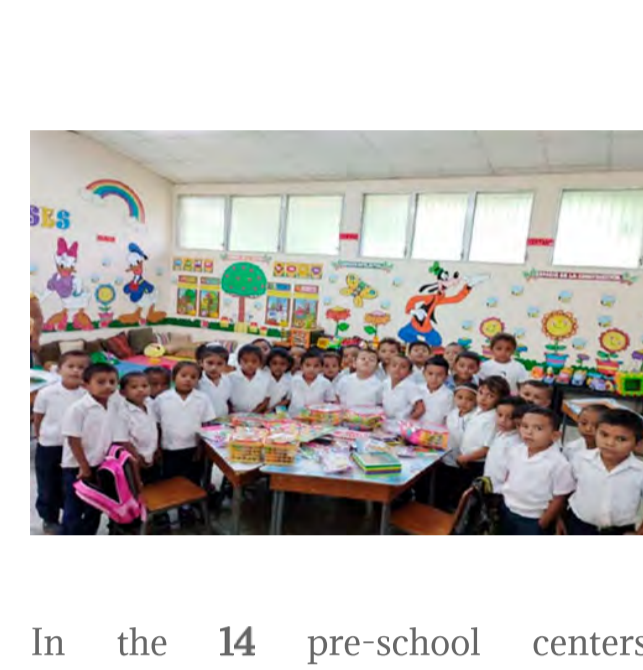
Early stimulation Care by sex Year 2023



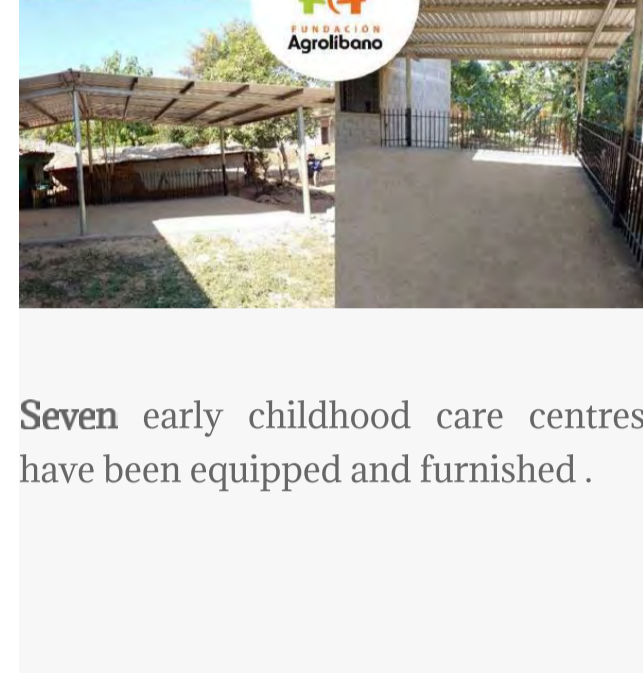
Training was provided to 190 volunteers who participate in comprehensive early childhood care activities.



14 pre-primary education centers served by PAIPI Modality III receive teaching materials to strengthen learning corners and facilitate the implementation of playful methodologies by teachers, benefiting 314 girls and boys from 3 to 6 years old and 18 teachers.



Improvements have been made to the infrastructure of 4 community spaces for early childhood care.



In the 14 pre-school centers, anthropometric measurements were taken for nutritional monitoring of school-aged children aged 3 to 6 years.



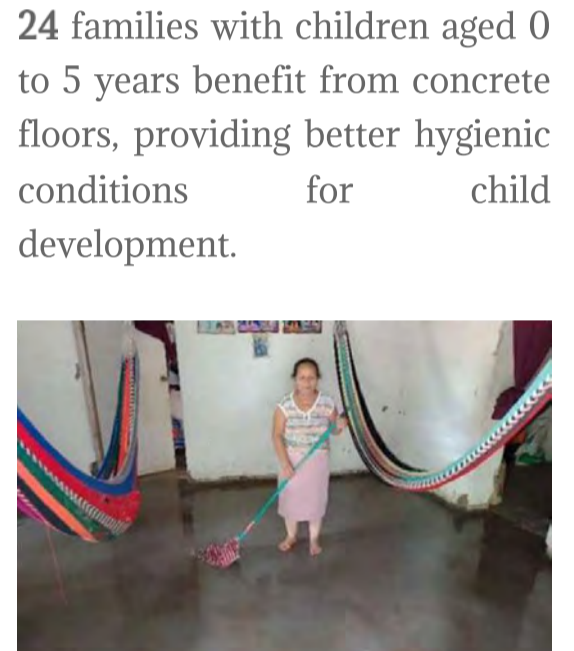

Healthy Family

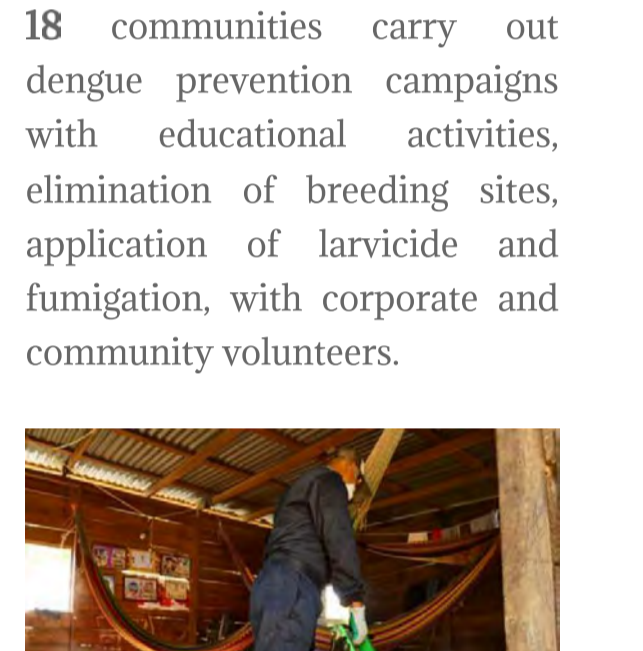
24 families with children aged 0 to 5 years benefit from concrete floors, providing better hygienic conditions for child development.



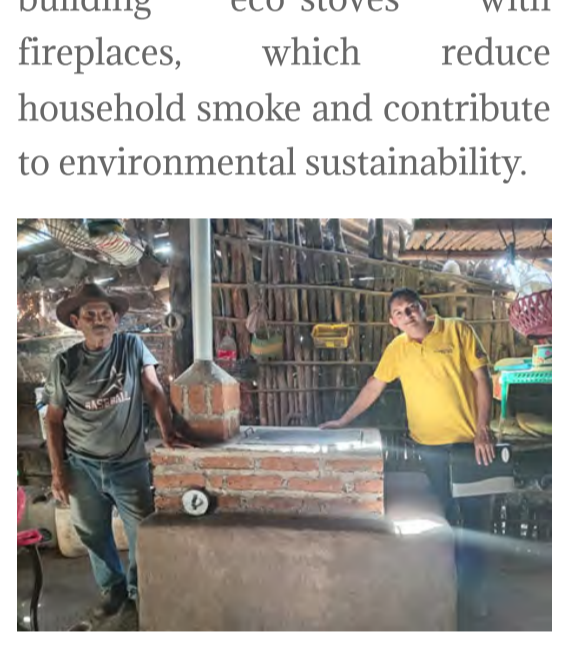
17 families improve basic sanitation conditions with the construction of a washable latrine connected to a septic tank, reducing deprivation linked to multidimensional poverty.



18 communities carry out dengue prevention campaigns with educational activities, elimination of breeding sites, application of larvicide and fumigation, with corporate and community volunteers.



8 families improve the conditions of their homes by building eco-stoves with fireplaces, which reduce household smoke and contribute to environmental sustainability.



49 families receive talks to promote better hygiene habits and fill out a survey on knowledge, attitudes and practices in healthy housing.



9 community water boards strengthened to improve drinking water quality, improve distribution networks and management plans for recharge areas.



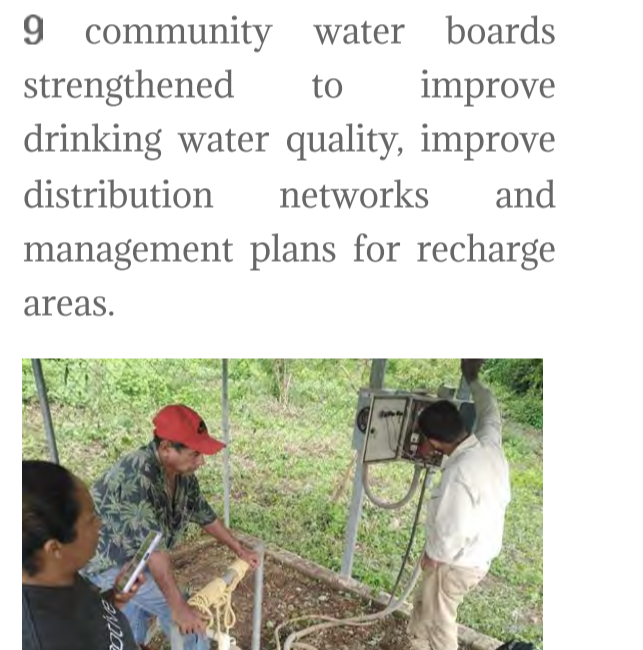
82 families that produce food in their family gardens are trained in biointensive farming, receive supplies and technical assistance



39 families improve their food security and nutrition by producing eggs and chickens in henhouses, receiving training, technical assistance and supplies for implementation.



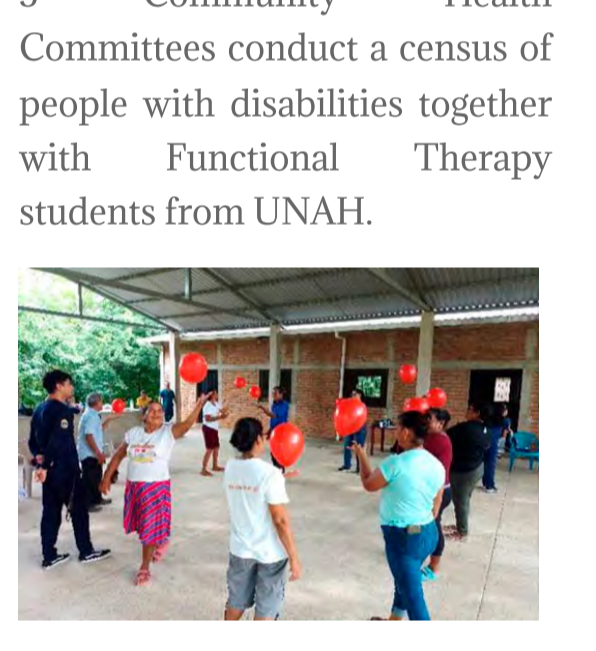

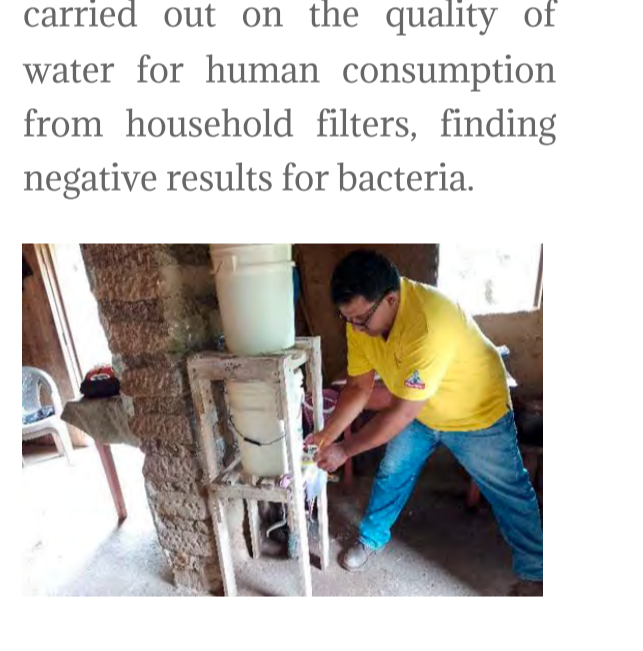

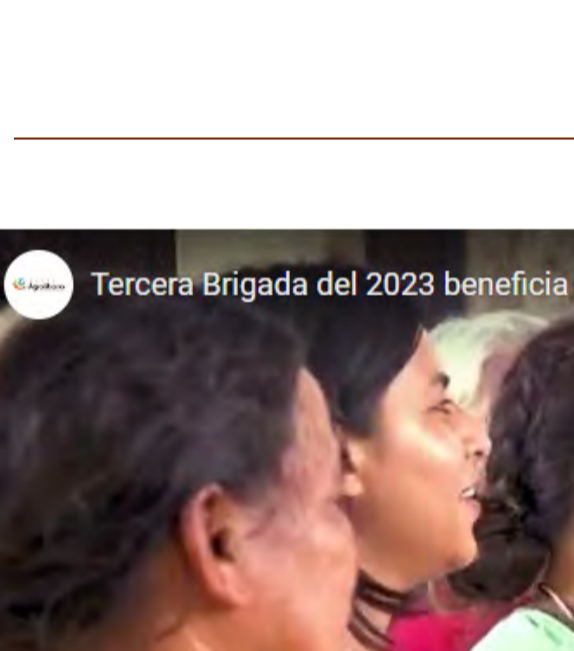
3 Communities Health Committees conduct a census of people with disabilities together with Functional Therapy students from UNAH.

2 school farms strengthened with improved irrigation systems.



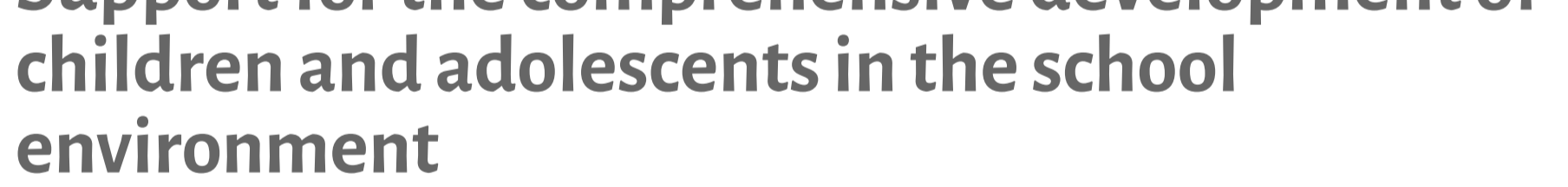

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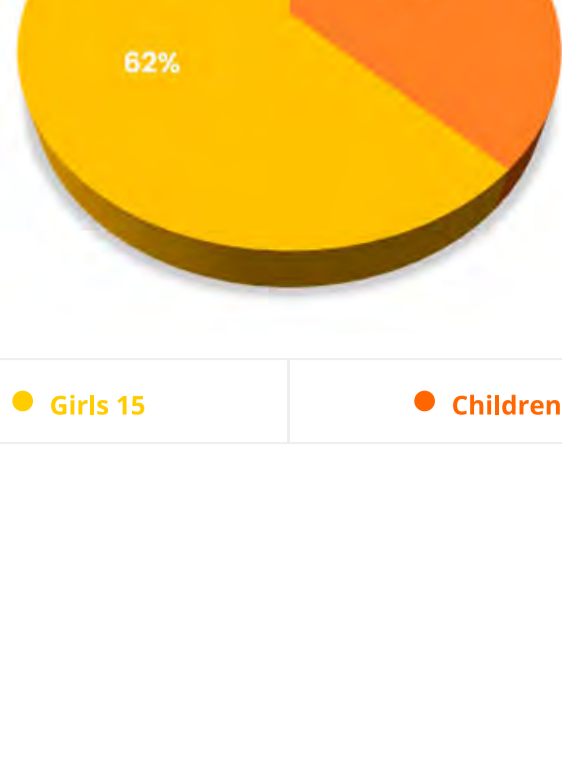

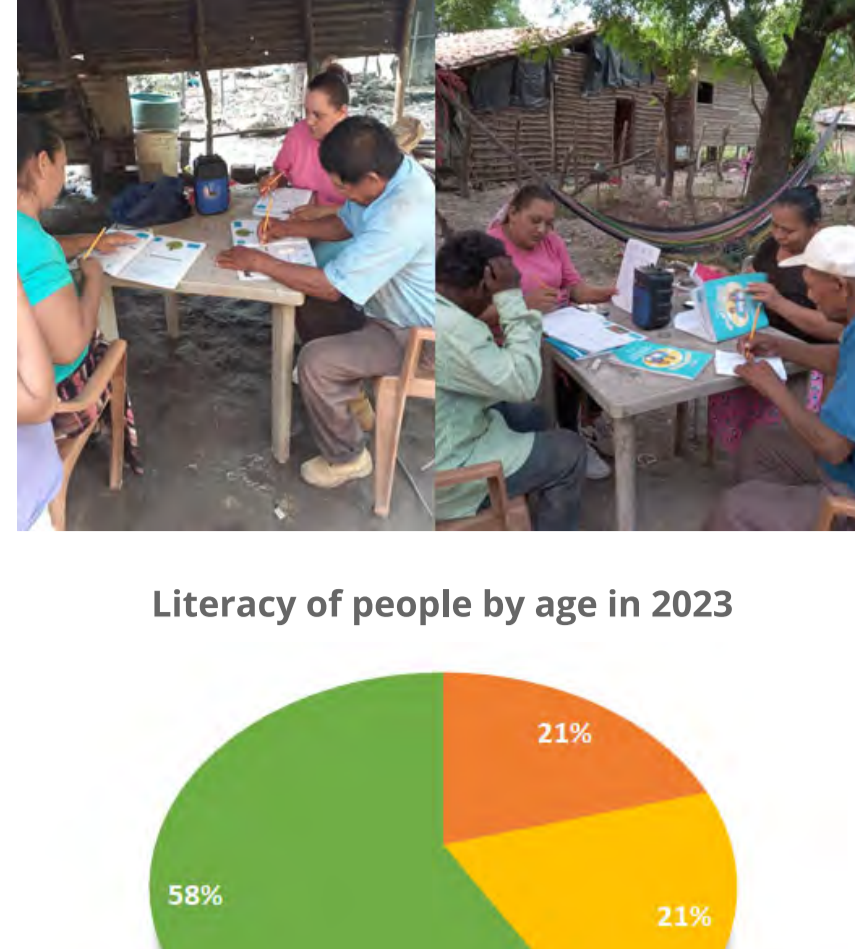
Children with access to pre-primary education in community centers, by gender

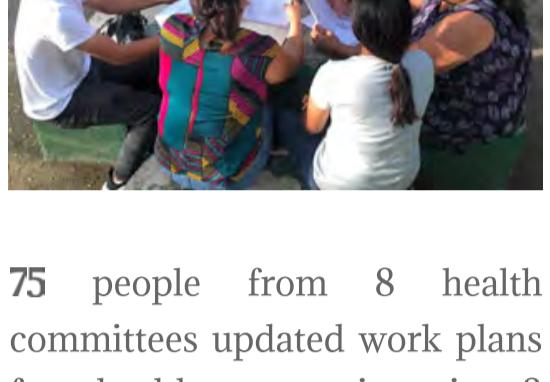


Literacy of people by age in 2023

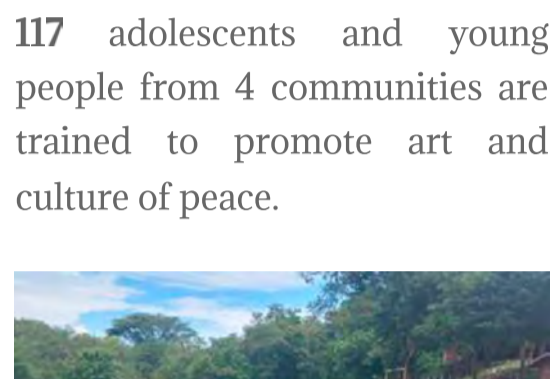


Strengthening citizen participation for peace and development

171 community leaders are strengthened with 18 hours of training to design community projects for rural development. In 3 communities, project formulation begins.



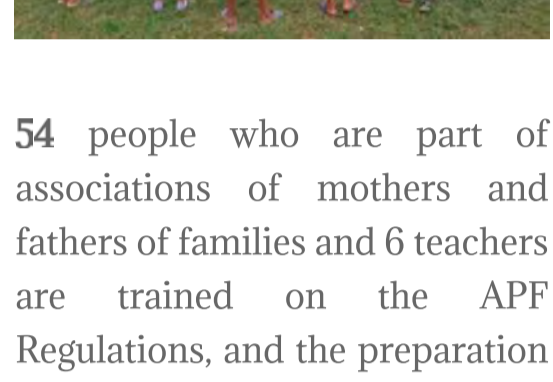
16 communities held sessions to analyse progress towards sustainable community development, with the participation of 391 people representing community-based organisations.

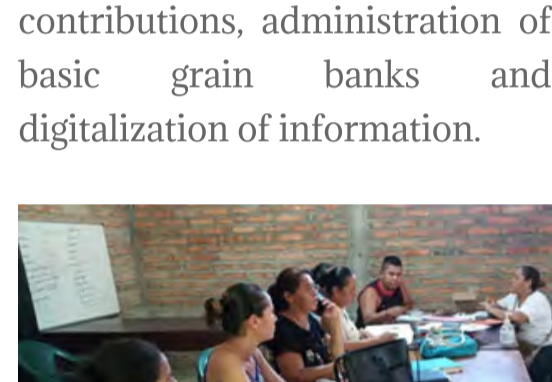
5,000 plants produced in 4 community nurseries in coordination with micro-basin councils and community water boards.



Members of 2 Microbasin Councils: Namasigüe and Calaire, received 36 hours of training on the application of internal regulations and care of the environment.



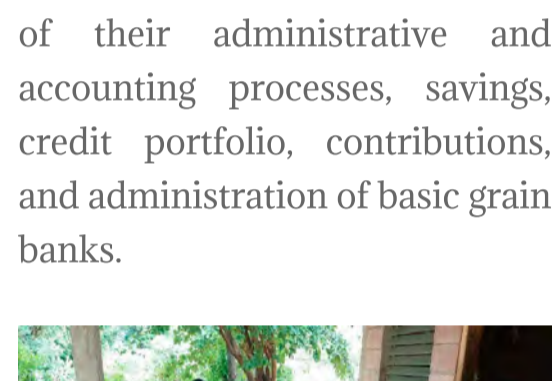

The Calaire Microbasin Council was supported in the construction of a 16-meter stone curtain to prevent erosion in the water source recharge area.



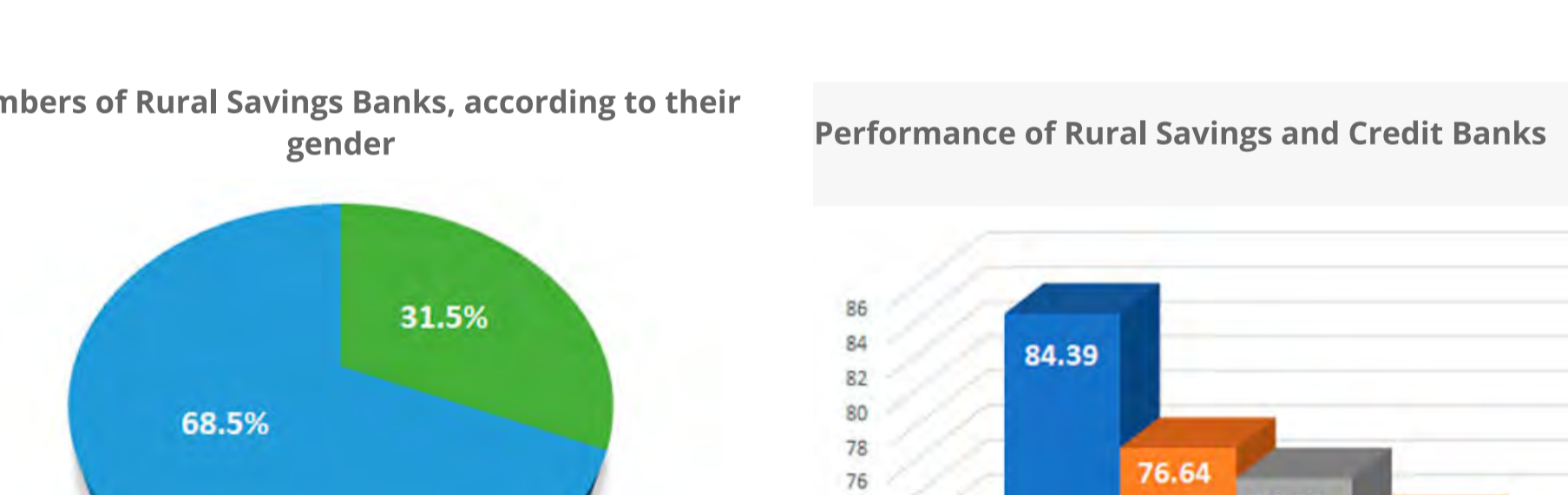
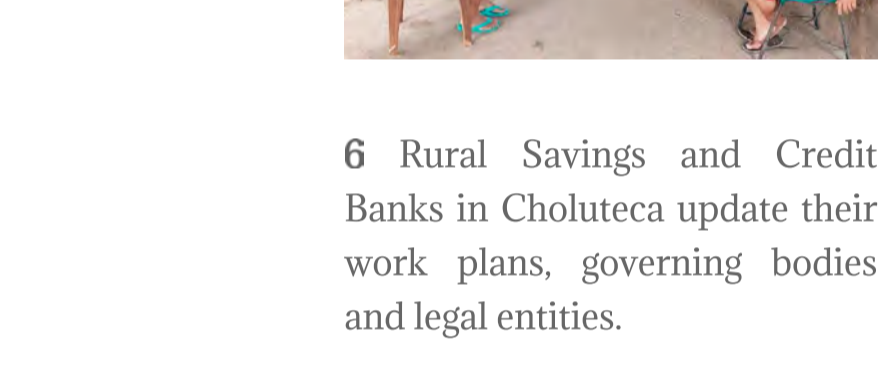

Institutional Development

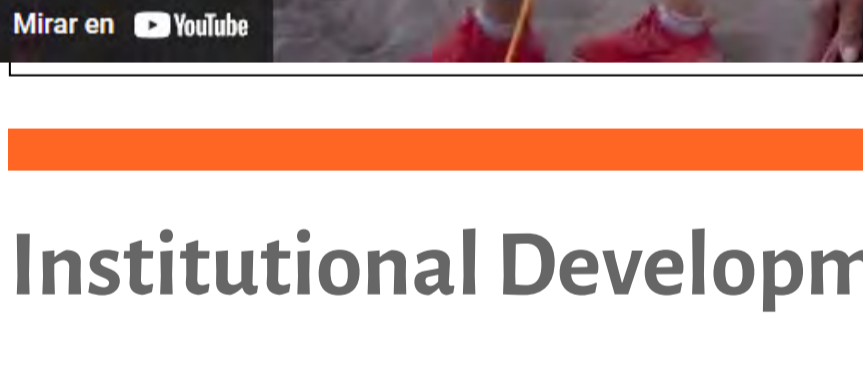
