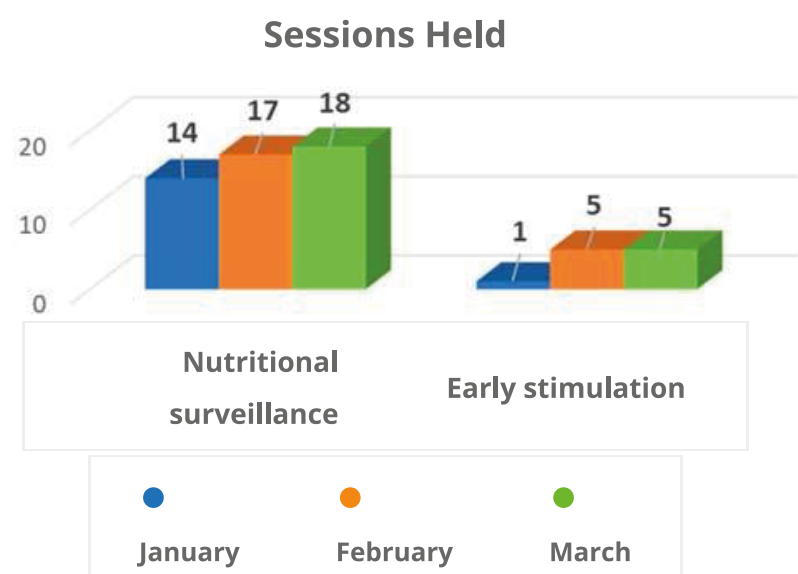
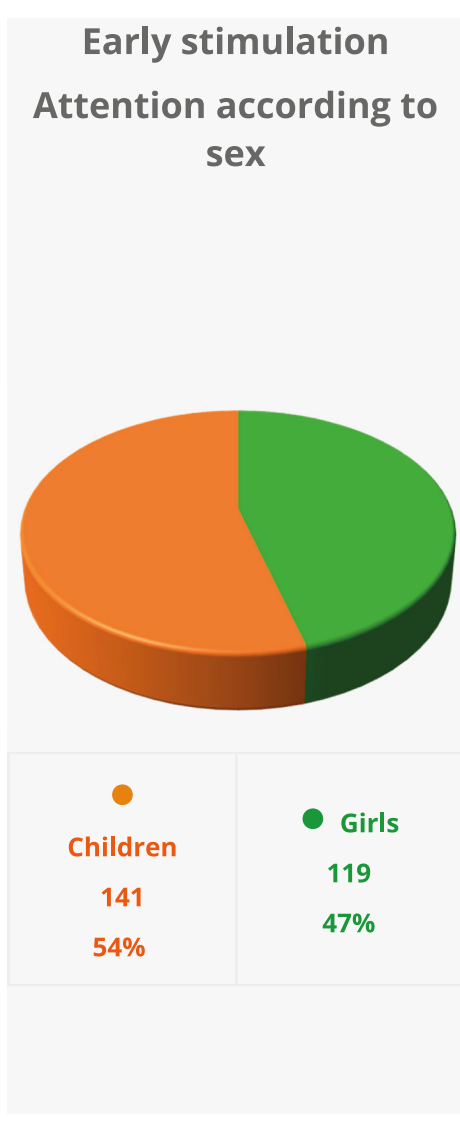
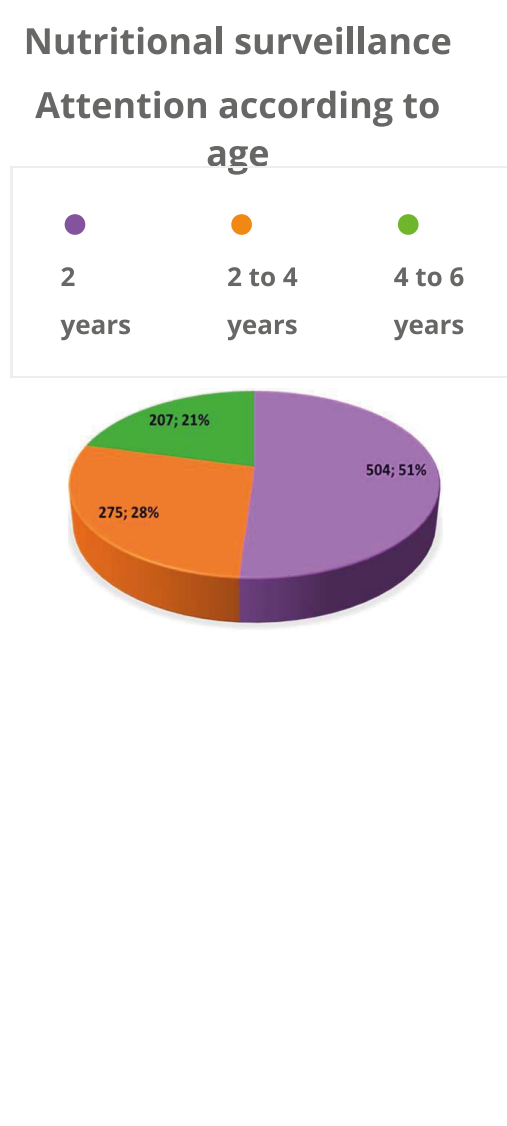
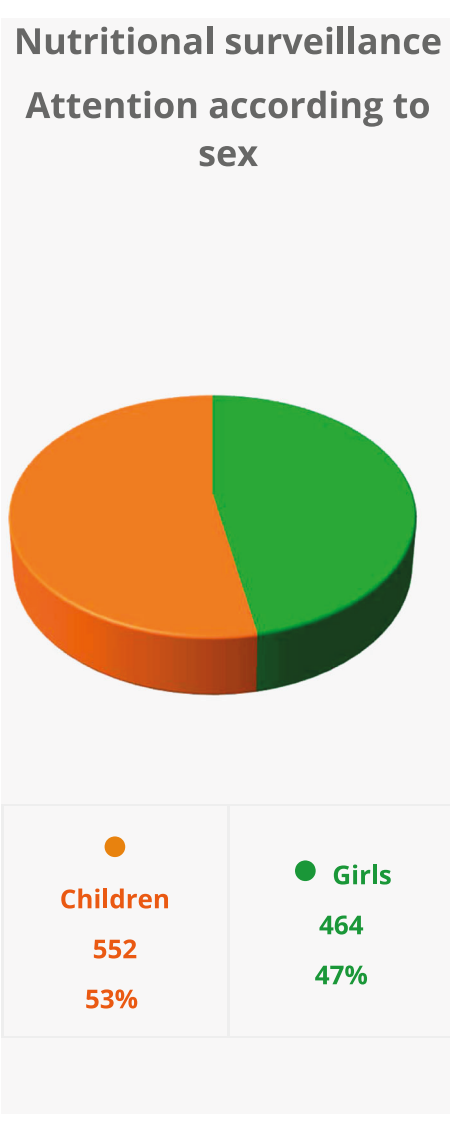


## Comprehensive care for early childhood

With your support at the beginning of life, 49 nutritional monitoring sessions and 11 early stimulation sessions have been carried out, providing a total of 986 services to children aged 0 to 5 years in 18 communities.



79 community volunteers participated in the comprehensive early childhood care activities. Training was provided to 10 new members.



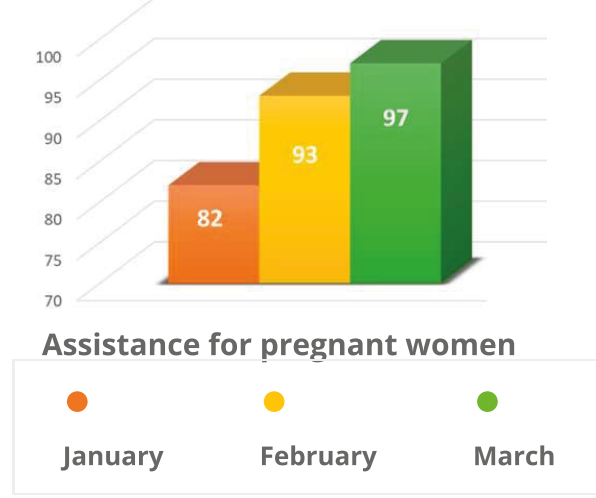
18,270 Nutributter sachets were distributed to 203 children aged 6 months to 2 years. This supplement provides essential nutrients for healthy growth and development.



## Safe Motherhood

With your support for safe motherhood, 19 educational sessions have been held with pregnant women's clubs in 18 communities.

15,450 sachets of the Enov Mum supplement were distributed to 175 pregnant and lactating women.

11 postpartum women were identified and given a safe maternity basket containing baby clothing and hygiene products.

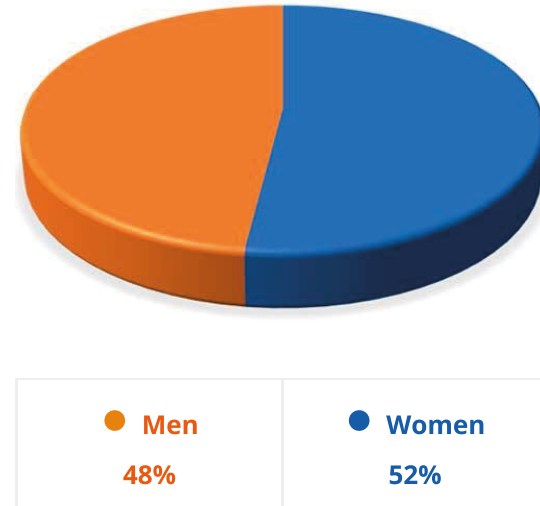


## Healthy Housing

In this first quarter of 2022, 15 families living in severe poverty are benefiting from healthy housing that includes a concrete floor, a bathroom with a septic tank, a shower, a sink/laundry room, an eco-stove, and access to drinking water.

25 people have been trained in healthy housing issues.

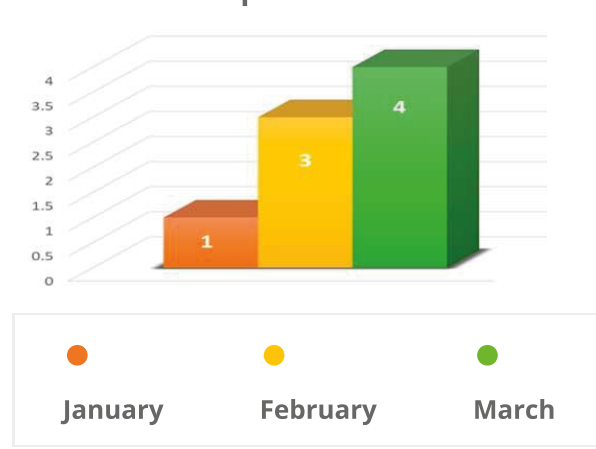

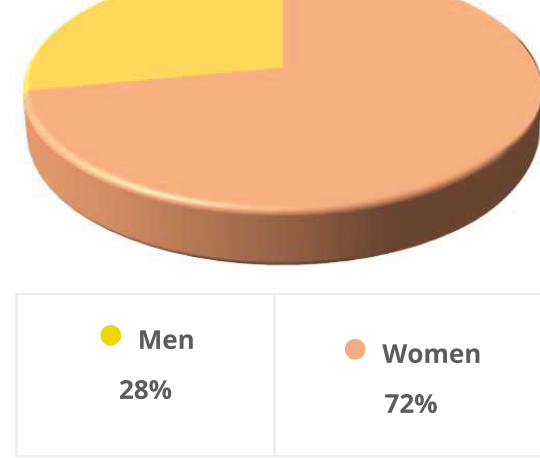
## Food Safety

**Trainings Yard Plan**

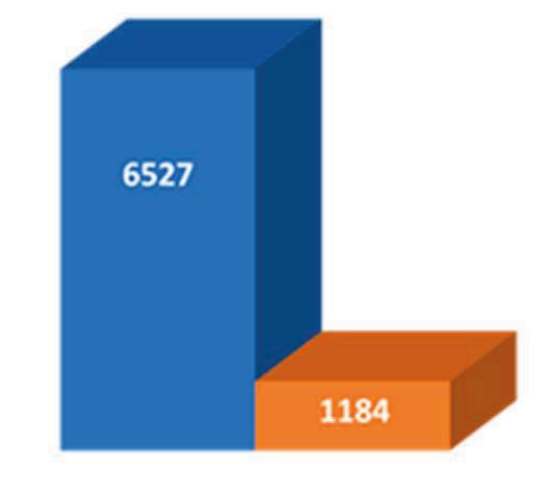

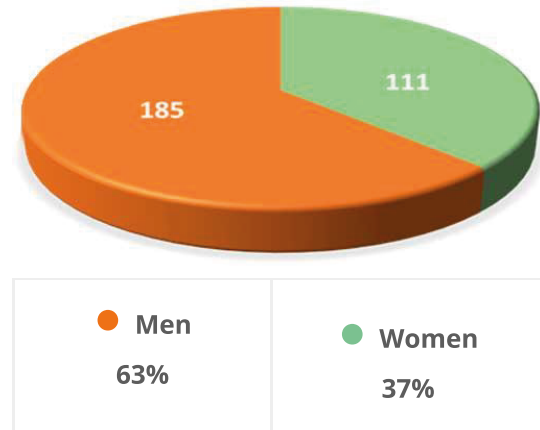

## Five Star Schools Program

In the first quarter of 2022, 5,038 textbooks were distributed in 14 public educational centers to strengthen reading and writing, benefiting 1,805 students from 1st to 6th grade. These educational centers were also provided with biosecurity material consisting of disposable masks, alcohol, sprays, and chlorine, benefiting 2,600 students from 1st to 9th grade and 112 teachers.
